Introduction

Then the righteous will shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. He who has ears, let him hear.


1 Corinthians 15:42-44

Matthew 8:12 (Context: Feast w/ Abraham)

...but the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Matthew 22:13 (Parable of Wedding Banquet)

Then the king said to the servants, "Bind him hand and foot, and throw him into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

Matthew 25:30 (Parable of Talents)

Throw out the worthless slave into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

2 Peter 2:4 (Fallen Angels)

For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into hell and committed them to pits of darkness, reserved for judgment...

Jude 6 (Fallen Angels)

And angels who did not keep their own domain, but abandoned their proper abode, He has kept in eternal bonds under darkness for the judgment of the great day...

Revelation 9:1-2 (Fifth Trumpet)

1 Then the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star from heaven which had fallen to the earth; and the key of the bottomless pit was given to him. 2 He opened the bottomless pit, and smoke went up out of the pit, like the smoke of a great furnace; and the sun and the air were darkened by the smoke of the pit.

Matthew 13:41-42 (Parable of Wheat & Weeds)

41 The Son of Man will send forth His angels, and they will gather out of His kingdom all stumbling blocks, and those who commit lawlessness, 42 and will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Hell as Weeping...

Matthew 13:49-50 (Parable of Dragnet)

49 So it will be at the end of the age; the angels will come forth and take out the wicked from among the righteous, 50 and will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Hell as Weeping...

Hell as Punishment, etc.

- Matthew 18:34
- Matthew 24:51
- Matthew 25:46
- Luke 12:46-48

Matthew 18:34-35 (Parable of Unmerciful Servant)

34 And his lord, moved with anger, handed him over to the torturers until he should repay all that was owed him. 35 My heavenly Father will also do the same to you, if each of you does not forgive his brother from your heart.

Matthew 24:50-51 (Parable of Wicked Servant)

50 the master of that slave will come on a day when he does not expect [him] and at an hour which he does not know, 51 and will cut him in pieces and assign him a place with the hypocrites; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Matthew 25:46 (Parable of Sheep & Goats)

These will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life.

Luke 12:46-48

46 the master of that slave will come on a day when he does not expect [him] and at an hour he does not know, and will cut him in pieces, and assign him a place with the unbelievers. 47 And that slave who knew his master's will and did not get ready or act in accord with his will, will receive many lashes, 48 but the one who did not know [it], and committed deeds worthy of a flogging, will receive but few. From everyone who has been given much, much will be required; and to whom they entrusted much, of him they will ask all the more.

Matthew 7:13-14 (Sermon on Mount)

13 Enter through the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way is broad that leads to destruction, and there are many who enter through it. 14 For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to life, and there are few who find it.

Matthew 10:28

Do not fear those who kill the body but are unable to kill the soul; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

2 Thessalonians 1:9

These will pay the penalty of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power...

Daniel 12:1-2

1 Now at that time Michael, the great prince who stands [guard] over the sons of your people, will arise. And there will be a time of distress such as never occurred since there was a nation until that time; and at that time your people, everyone who is found written in the book, will be rescued. 2 Many of those who sleep in the dust of the ground will awake, these to everlasting life, but the others to disgrace [and] everlasting contempt.

Mark 9:47-48 (Causing Little Ones to Sin)

47 If your eye causes you to stumble, throw it out; it is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye, than, having two eyes, to be cast into hell, 48 where their worm does not die, and the fire is not quenched.

Isaiah 66:23-24 (New Heavens & New Earth)

23 And it shall be from new moon to new moon And from sabbath to sabbath, All mankind will come to bow down before Me, says the Lord. 24 Then they will go forth and look On the corpses of the men Who have transgressed against Me. For their worm will not die And their fire will not be quenched; And they will be an abhorrence to all mankind.

Revelation 14:9-12

9 Then another angel, a third one, followed them, saying with a loud voice, "If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives a mark on his forehead or on his hand, 10 he also will drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is mixed in full strength in the cup of His anger; and he will be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb. 11 And the smoke of their torment goes up forever and ever; they have no rest day and night, those who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name." 12 Here is the perseverance of the saints who keep the commandments of God and their faith in Jesus.

Revelation 22:14-15

14 Blessed are those who wash their robes, so that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter by the gates into the city. 15 Outside are the dogs and the sorcerers and the immoral persons and the murderers and the idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices lying.

Hell a place of:

- Fire
- Darkness
- Weeping & gnashing of teeth
- Punishment, torturers, beating, cutting in pieces
- Destruction
- Away from the presence of the Lord

Some Clarifications

- Hell is not (in the Bible) pictured as a place were Satan & the demons are tormenting anyone.
- Rather, Satan & his helpers are chief prisoners of hell.
