Some Observations:

- ** Note US war deaths. Since 1976, there have been more US abortions *each year* than the total war deaths in US history.
- ** Compare rapes with abortions: the latter outnumber the former by about 20 to 1.
- ** Compare all deaths with abortion: the number who are killed before birth each year is more than 3/4ths the number of born people (babies thru elderly) who die each year; there are more deaths by abortion than by heart disease and cancer combined.
- ** If abortions are taken into account, life expectancy in the US drops from 75 to 53!
- ** Nazi holocaust surpassed by US abortions by middle of 1978. By end 1990, est. total US abortions almost 25 million, about 4 times Nazi total.

SCIENTIFIC CONSIDERATIONS

Safety to Mother:

Slightly safer to abort than to give birth But why restrict consideration to mother?

Certainly not safer for child!

Is Fetus Human?

Not an onion! What *scientific* warrant for a "no" answer? Is rabbit fetus a rabbit? How is fetus different from unfertilized egg? Full vs half set of genetic material What difference does "viability" make?
Partly a matter of technology
